



Kurisa Moya Nature Lodge

Kurisa Moya is a beautiful nature lodge in the Northern / Limpopo Province of South Africa. This haven is nestled in the Northern Drakensberg escarpment and overlooks the breathtaking Kudu River Valley and is only 45 minutes from the city of Pietersburg / Polokwane and 20 minutes from the mountain village of Haenertsburg and the beautiful Magoebaskloof.

Kurisa Moya, meaning Tranquil Spirit, enjoys a strategic position that blesses it with temperate weather which nurtures a beautiful indigenous forest where a large variety of birds, animals and flora can be seen. Large stretches of indigenous forest give way to African bush-veld on the lower part of the farm where two dams are fed by clean mountain streams.

Activities at Kurisa Moya include bird-watching, hiking and trout fishing in the dams where otters and water birds can also be seen. Samango monkeys, baboons, bushbuck, bushbabies, vervet monkeys, warthogs and bushpigs are often seen or heard on the hiking trails or from the venues. In addition to the trails, Ben and Lisa also offer cranio-sacral therapy, guided bird and nature walks, fly-fishing lessons abseiling, mountain biking and back massages... to name but a few.

Thora Boloka Cottage is an earthy venue with spectacular views into the valley below.

ECO - RATING



Kurisa Moya has an excellent attitude towards energy conservation. The property is completely electricity-free, computers run on solar power and main appliances run on gas. Staff are also trained in operating in an electricity-free environment. The staff encourage minimum water usage with linen re-use programmes and grey water recycling which helps to maintain the beautiful gardens.



The Farmhouse, with its mountain and indigenous forest setting, is perfect for bigger groups.

Kurisa Moya has a fine-tuned educational aspect, as staff are encouraged and trained to act in an environmentally responsible way. There is a healthy partnership with local (rural) schools where guests can donate items and get involved in their upkeep if they so wish. The staff works extensively in other local eco-projects and even run their own carbon-offsetting scheme through which guests are able to plant trees at local schools and clinics. They also run guided nature walks and promote village home-stays. This love for local life runs in their business relationships too and Kurisa Moya encourages guests to visit local artisans and artists whilst insisting on the use of local suppliers for their own provisions. There is plenty of literature on all the activities undertaken in the property and a very complete, written eco-constitution.

Kurisa Moya has been awarded the highest "Eco Hotels of the World" rating of 5 stars.

Kurisa Moya's Forest Lodge Cabins are 3 metres up in the indigenous forest canopy.
